Since 1971 Foundation Sjofar has seen it as her calling to familiarize people with the Word of God in accordance with the instructions of Paul to Timothy — '…*rightly dividing the Word of Truth*' (2 Tim. 2:15).

For a long time important passages of the Holy Scripture have not been discussed, for various reasons. Only when the Bible is preached and taught in its entirety is the Word of God shown to full advantage; only then is the Bible understandable. After all, the Bible is not just a religious book but a fascinating written account of God's Plan of Salvation.

This is why we thought it instructive and useful to compile a comprehensive text survey. It contains a chronological arrangement of Bible passages in accordance with God's Plan of Salvation. Scripture divides the time in 'times and seasons', 'dispensations', 'days', 'ages' and 'worlds'. Each period has a beginning and an end, and is closed with a judgment. The dispensations differ from each other in the way God deals with people in different periods.

This survey has its limitations but we hope you are encouraged to study the Word of God in order to gain insight into God's Plan. While attentively searching the Scriptures you will discover that they in their entirety have a clear design that gets its fulfilment throughout the ages, until the Second Coming of the Lord Jesus and the manifestation of God's Kingdom in heaven and on earth.

THE SONS OF NOAH

Genesis relates the history of the origin of mankind, the nations. Genesis contains eight genealogical registers.

THE TIME [DISPENSATION] OF THE PATRIARCHS

God **chose** one man, from the seed of Shem, **Abram**, to proceed with His Plan of Salvation: **the Covenant** (Hebrew: 'berith') that **God** established with **Abram**, **Isaac and Jacob**.

The Biblical Attributes of a covenant

A covenant is made between people who <u>do not have a natural relationship</u>. Strangers become brothers because of a 'berith' (covenant). Characteristic is that a berith is u n breakable. It's n at ure (duration) is eternal, everlasting. It has legality (**legal authority!**). It is stronger than death – it <u>stretches over the generations</u>. It is often **sealed** with **an oath**, a sacrifice, and a meal, etc. God establishes a covenant with Noah, Abram, the people of Israel, David; The New Covenant

THE BOOK OF JUDGES

Judges, twelve in all, governed the people of Israel over a period of about 400 years after Joshua had died and the people had been freed from the power of their adversaries. The most well-known judges are Gideon, Deborah, Jephthah and Samson.

SAMUEL - the great reformer

The time described in the book of Judges can be seen as 'the dark Middle Ages' in the history of the people of Israel. A tragic low point is **the plunder of the ark** by the Philistines. 1 Sam. 4:21,22*The glory has departed from Israel, for the ark of God has been captured.* In 1 Cor. 10:11 we read that the history of Israel was written for our admonition, *on whom the ends of the ages have come.* It is God's mercy that He always takes pity on His people in days of great terror. He raises up men and women who pull Israel out of the valley of misery and cause Israel to turn back

to the God of the Covenant which He had made with their fathers, a covenant that would stand firm until the most distant generations.

Samuel, an exceptionally gifted versatile leader carried out many reforms. He is the last judge (Acts 13:20), head of the prophets (1 Sam. 10:10-12; 19:20-21), Levite. Samuel <u>anoints</u> Saul and David king and acts as their <u>advisor</u>, he writes Chronicles (1 Chron. 29:29) and is above all things a dedicated <u>intercessor</u> (1 Sam. 12:23; Ps. 99:6; Jer. 15:1).

THE KINGS

Israel is a THEOCRACY ^(*) .	[Greek: 'theos' = God; 'krateoo' = to rule.]
^(*) Until this day Israel is not called a Rep	ublic. Israel is waiting for the Coming of its King.

Theocracy is a form of government in which the government of state belongs to God;

YHWH is the LAWGIVER. God wants to dwell among His people; God is in charge of the establishment of the state administration. See also: Judges, Samuel; The Covenant with David.

The tabernacle stood in the midst of the people.

<u>The ark</u>, with the **Mercy** Seat on top and in the ark 'the Testimony' (the Law), was placed in the Holy of Holies. Right there the LORD spoke with Moses: *I will speak with you* [Moses]...*about everything which I will give you in commandment to the children of Israel.* (Exo. 25:22)

Not obeying God and not submitting to God's commandments Saul was rejected by God. 1 Sam. 15 (see verses 22-23); Hos. 13:1

The king had to govern the land, administer justice, and be in the forefront of the army.

<u>Prophets</u> were often **counsellors**/advisors of the king: Samuel, Nathan (king David), Elijah, Elisha, Isaiah (king Hezekiah) and Jeremiah at the time of the last kings before the exile.

There were also counsellors who tried to mislead kings (see 1 Ki. 22 - king Ahab). Also (high)priests and even 'queen-mothers' took important positions in order to advise the king, for good or for evil.

In Biblical times Israel had a clear separation of powers: <u>king – prophet – priest</u>.

A sovereign like Abraham or a king like David could have prophetic gifts. (Gen. 20:7; Acts 2:30) But David could <u>not</u> be both <u>king and priest</u> (have <u>spiritual leadership</u>),

for that would mean political and spiritual totalitarian power (see King Uzziah – (2 Chr. 26:16-22).

Only the Lord Jesus has all four offices in Himself:

Prophet and High Priest	\rightarrow	at the time of His first coming on earth
Judge and then King	\rightarrow	at His second coming on earth

Time and time again God sent out warnings through the mouth of many prophets. Finally and inevitably God had to intervene and the people Israel went into exile. The glory of the LORD withdrew from Israel...(Ezek. 9-11) ...until The Day...

(Ezek. 40-48; Matt. 23:39).

The PROPHETS

Hebr. 'nabi' = speaker, preacher of the Word of God; also called 'seer'

(1 Sam. 9:9)

In the time of the kings, especially in the time before the exile (to Assyria (the Ten Tribes) and Babylon (Judah)), **the prophets of the LORD** warned the people of Israel time after time of the Lord's judgments that awaited them because of their idolatry.

<u>Isaiah</u>, <u>Jeremiah</u>, <u>Ezekiel</u> and <u>Daniel</u> are the best known prophets. However, '<u>the twelve minor prophets</u>' (so called because of their short writings) proclaimed <u>remarkably striking statements of the Lord</u> as well — statements confirmed by later history.

Many **theologians try to spiritualize** these **prophecies**, or they claim that the prophets' messages were written down in the Bible at a much later time, after the events.

THE END OF THE EXILE — Ezra, Nehemiah

- to all countries of the earth (after that back to the land of their fathers, the Promised Land).

The temple service could **not** be resumed **until** <u>the walls</u> around Jerusalem had been **restored**. Therefore God put it in Nehemiah's heart to help his brothers; again enmity everywhere. <u>Nehemiah</u> prayed! A close unanimous Jewish community built and protected city and wall (444 BC). When the <u>walls</u> around Jerusalem had been **repaired** and <u>the temple</u> **rebuilt** (in \pm 440 BC):

'The Time is at hand' Foundation Sjofar the Netherlands 2012

INTERIM PERIOD ± 400 BC — 4 AD

On Tisha B'Av, the 9th of the month of Av(*), in 587 BC, Nebuchadnezzar destroyed Jerusalem, burned the temple and carried the people of Judea to Babel into exile.

In exile the Jews did not have a temple; yet in order to give their spiritual life form and purpose they built synagogues and introduced a religious guide such as the Talmud and the Gemara. In 538 BC King **Cyrus** of **Persia** gave the Jewish people **opportunity to return to Jerusalem**,

in order to rebuild 'the House of the Lord, the God of Israel, the God Who lives in Jerusalem.' After a difficult start a successful end was reached because of the words of the prophets Haggai and Zechariah, the scribe Ezra and the governor (stadholder) Nehemiah,

'... even in troublesome times'

(Dan. 9:25!).

The <u>last person to speak was the prophet Malachi</u>; he urged the Jewish people to return to the Law of Moses. **Then there was silence**. During a period of about **400 years** God's Words, spoken by prophets, were not heard. This would last **until** John, the Baptist, the forerunner of the great PROPHET, about Whom Moses had said: *The LORD your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your midst, from your brethren. Him you shall hear*... (Deut. 18:15).

At that time Israel lived between hope and fear. The Medo-Persian Empire was replaced by the **Greek Empire**. The ruler of the Greek Empire was the brilliant world conqueror <u>Alexander the Great</u>. He had made it his object to found a world empire with **a multi-cultural** or rather a **cosmopolitan**, **democratic society** in which all cultures and religions were **merged**. Israel did not escape this '**Hellenistic**' influence! (see Lev. 20:24; 1 Ki. 8:51,53)

Israel between 'hammer and anvil'

Dan. 10:1-12In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia a message was revealed to Daniel, ...[in 536 BC]The message was true, but the appointed time was long;
and he [Daniel] understood the message, and had understanding of the vision.

After Alexander's death four of his generals appropriated each a part of the empire. That was attended by rivalry and hate. Judea became **a buffer-state** between the **north**ern realm (of the Seleucids) and the **south**ern realm (of the Ptolemies). Because of their strife Judea was repeatedly trampled underfoot. Chapter **11** of <u>the book of Daniel</u> gives **a prophetic (!) striking description** of that time, in accordance with the facts of that period!

The conduct of Antiochus IV Epiphanes [175-164 BC] was a low point.

Retreating from the South after a failed battle <u>Antiochus Epiphanes</u> took revenge on the Jewish people. He invaded Jerusalem on the Shabbat, sowing death and destruction. On the Temple Mount he built an altar. He defiled the altar by sacrificing swine on it, sacrifices to Zeus. (see Lev. 11:7-8,11) At a critical moment <u>priest Mattathias of Modiïn</u> and his five sons rose in revolt against this idol worship and gave the signal for a heroic war of independence, '**the battle of the Maccabees**'.

On the 25th of Kislev 165 BC they successfully recaptured the Temple. This event became known as **'the feast of Chanukah'** — initiation. However, the assaults from the northern empire continued. About 140 BC Simon, the last surviving son of the priest Mattathias, became ruler of the Jewish realm. Simon's descendants became known as <u>'the Hasmonean dynasty</u>'. They gave themselves the title of **king ánd** the office of **high priest** [see page 30!]. **Decay was the result!**

(*) On **Tisha B'Av**, the 9th of the month of Av, in 70 AD, the Roman general Titus destroyed the Second Temple in Jerusalem. Israel went into exile again. It ended up in a diaspora, a dispersion to the end of the earth.

<u>Two sons from this dynasty</u> (two brothers) **competed fiercely** for the honorary titles <u>king</u> and <u>high priest</u>. Each of them **appealed to the Romans to interfere.**

The Romans gladly complied with the request! In 63 BC the Roman general Pompey entered Jerusalem. Judea and the area north of it were violently subdued and **annexed to the Roman empire** and became **part** of the 'Syrian province' (see Luke 2:1-2).

In earlier years John Hyrcanus, high priest and ethnarch, had strived to extend the regained Jewish area. In 135 BC he succeeded in adding Idumaea to Judea. He **forced the people of Idumaea to embrace Judaism**. Because of this double nationality and his own craftiness Antipater, the Idumaean, father of Herod

the Great, could be appointed in 47 BC as governor of Judea by the Romans.

Due to **self-overestimation** and **internal misgovernment** the Jewish people had once again fallen prey to the domination of a cruel foreign world power.

Features of the Roman Empire

The rulers of the Roman Empire, just like those of previous empires, aimed at a **World order**, now **under dominion of Rome.** They carried out **a 'divide and rule' policy**. Really everything was done to make the Empire work. Everywhere <u>new roads</u> were constructed and '<u>all roads led to Rome</u>'!

Roman <u>legislation and jurisdiction</u> were introduced as well as <u>a monetary system</u>. (Luke 20) <u>Borders were opened</u>. <u>Koine Greek served as the official language</u>, enabling merchants and diplomats to make themselves understood in each province of the Empire.

But **the Romans ruled with an iron hand**. The conquered nations had to <u>pay contribution</u> [see Luke 5. and 19., the publicans] and to supply their own produce to their rulers.

<u>Revolts</u> were <u>cruelly dispersed</u> and those who resisted the Roman policy were oppressed.

The worst form of oppression

Every subject of the Roman Empire had the obligation to bring **an offering to the Roman emperor** once a year - 'disobedience' was punishable with a cruel death. In this way the Roman **emperor received divine honor**. After many battles and blood shed the Jewish leaders were able to get exemption from this obligation. Later on those from the heathen world who followed Jesus did not receive this exemption. Especially at the time of Emperor <u>Nero</u> they suffered severely.

The Bible speaks about this time period as 'the fullness of the times'

Gal. 4:4 ...when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son... After many centuries of exile, oppression, persecution and suffering Israel was longing for a new revelation of the Kingdom of God.

About Simeon, who held the Child Jesus in his arms, is written:

Luke 2:25 ...this man was just and devout, waiting for the Consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him.

and the Hoty Spirit was upon him.

And also the prophetess Anna, of the tribe of Asher, met the Child Jesus.

Many parts in the Gospels express this longing for rest and peace,

The Lord Jesus had to come <u>first</u> for **the Atonement** of <u>the sins of mankind</u>, and it is amazing <u>that Israel's</u> <u>rejection</u> of <u>Jesus as REDEEMER</u> **meant the salvation of the world.** (Rom. 11:15a)

THE FOUR GOSPELS

The first four books of the New Testament were called 'Gospels' — the message of good tidings. The term refers to the fulfillment of God's promises of salvation Luke 2:10

- for the salvation of man and of creation. 2. The Foundation of God's Kingdom, to the praise and honor of the Name of God. Rev. 4:11; 5:12-13; 15:3-4

The four Gospels reveal the Person and Work of the Lord Jesus

The Gospels constitute the key to the Bible. They serve as a focal point: all lines in the Old Testament point to the Gospels, the Gospels are the point at which all lines of the Old Testament meet and the point from which they continue. Luke 24:25-44

The four gospels describe the Life and Work of the Lord Jesus during His walk on earth. The four gospels partly overlap; each gospel contains unique descriptions as well. Compare this with the description of the four cherubim in Ezek. 1 and Rev. 4:6-8 (the cherubim have faces like a man, a lion, an ox and an eagle and characterize the work of Jesus on earth as well).

In His office as prophet, the Lord Jesus shows the people of Israel that He is **The Prophet**, foretold by Moses, and the promised Messiah, Son of David Deut. 18:15; John 1:45; Acts 3:22-24; 7:37 Deut. 18:18 *I* [the Lord] will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee... And there arose not a prophet since in Israel like unto Moses, whom the LORD knew Deut. 34:10-11 face to face, iIn all the signs and the wonders which the LORD sent him... <u>The Gospel of John</u>, symbolized by the eagle \rightarrow Jesus, the Son of God The eagle: image of heavenly loftiness.

In the Gospel of John Jesus emphatically testifies — 40 times — that He is 'sent by God'. The Lord Jesus, as **SON of GOD**, came to earth to fulfill the Will of God, His Father: the Redemption of sin, death and everlasting destruction, for everyone who believes in Him. Luke 1:32,35; 3:22; John 1:14,34,49,50; 3:16,17,18; 5:25; 11:4,27; 20:31; Mat. 27:54 In the Gospel of John about **40** times the Lord Jesus is referred to as: '**the One sent by God**.' The coming of the Kingdom of God postponed

- 1. **Jesus Christ has come to find and to redeem** *the lost sheep of the house of Israel* (Matt.15:24) and vicariously die the death of sinners, in order to conquer death.
 - Israel Acts 2:36-39

Therefore let <u>all the house of Israel know assuredly</u> that God has made this Jesus, Whom you crucified, both Lord [Kurios - Ruler] and Christ... Men...what shall we do? For the promise is to you [Israel] and to your children, and to all who are afar off (*), as many as the Lord our God will call.

[(*) litt: the people of Israel (!) 'that went to the distance' (i.e. in exile abroad)]

<u>If the people of Israel as a whole</u> had accepted the Lord Jesus **after** His suffering, death, resurrection and ascension, **King Jesus would have returned <u>there</u>** and <u>then</u>, two thousand years ago. <u>The Kingdom of God</u> in heaven and on earth would have started there and <u>then</u>.

The majority of the Jewish people continued to reject the Lord Jesus as the coming Messiah sent from God. And <u>then a hardening</u> (**blindness**) in part happened to Israel.

...*their minds were blinded*; for until this day remaineth the same veil untaken away in the reading of the Old Testament, which veil is done away in Christ. - 2 Cor. 3:14-15, KJV

After many of the people Israel rejected Jesus Christ, the apostle Paul said: From henceforth *I* will go unto the Gentiles. ... to bring salvation unto the ends of the earth Acts 13:46-48, 49 28:16-29 18:6: Since then the Gentiles have been given **priority**, after their conversion and rebirth, **together with** the faithful remnant of Israel (Rom. 11:1-5) — to become part of the Body of Christ (the Church) formed on the day of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit (Pentecost), Acts 2; 15:8 The sequence is: first Jerusalem, then Samaria, then the Gentiles, individuals, Acts 2.; 8.; 10. At first Paul preached the Gospel of the Kingdom of God; Acts 8:12; 28:23 later on he calls it the Gospel of Grace: Paul: ... the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God ...among whom I have gone preaching the kingdom of God Acts 20:24-25

3. The Church — the Body of Christ — the dispensation of Grace

Paul explains in Eph. 3 and in Rom. 16:25-26 that this period, a new period — the formation of the Church, the Body of Christ — was **a mystery** in Old Testament times.

By revelation the LORD made known this mystery to Paul, first to him (Eph. 3). The Church consists of born again Jews and born again Gentiles (Christians, non-Jews). Paul wrote his letters for the Church. The Church is a people **next to** Israel. The Church is **not** the continuation of Israel, it is not a 'spiritual Israel'.

The teaching that Israel has been replaced by the Church is false. Child baptism, as a means for <u>supporting</u> this dogma, is an <u>unbiblical</u> assumption too.

The New Testament tells us **nowhere** that the formation of the Church meant the end of **Israel as God's Salvation organ**. **God chose Israel**. And God does not forsake the works of His Hands. 'The time of mercy' is almost over — the Jewish people return to their own country Israel from all the countries in the world. This is in line with the yet to be fulfilled promises of God. **Israel, a royal priesthood, is waiting for the Messiah, the coming Kingdom of God**.

Paul explains to the Gentiles God's judgment on Israel

At the end of the Tribulation: <u>the sun shall be darkened</u> and <u>the moon shall not give her light</u>, and the <u>stars</u> <u>shall fall from heaven</u> and <u>the powers of the heavens shall be shaken</u>; and then shall appear **the sign of the Son of Man** in heaven. Then shall <u>all the tribes</u> of the earth <u>mourn</u>, and they shall <u>see the Son of Man</u> <u>coming</u> in the clouds of heaven **with great power and glory** (Matt. 24:29-30, 27). The majestic, impressive, visible Second Coming of King Jesus - so will be the coming of the Son of Man.

Shortly before the Great Tribulation the Lord Jesus will take His Church to Himself, suddenly and unexpectedly. After 'the Rapture' God will pour out His wrath and punishment over the world (Rev. 4; 5). ... *the things which shall be hereafter* – after the time of Grace, of the Church - (Rev. 1:19; 4:1)

It is important to read **Ezekiel** <u>36</u> in its entirety, then chapters <u>37, 38 and 39</u>. And dwell on Ezekiel chapters 40-48 which describe the construction of the new temple. The new temple will be in Zion (Jerusalem) at the time of the coming of God's Kingdom on earth. Then the Glory of the LORD will go from the Mount of Olives, through 'the Golden gate' 'which faces toward the east' and enter the House of the LORD and fill it. (Ezek. 43:4,5; 44:4) Then the LORD will dwell in Zion, and out of Zion His Word and Law will go out 'into all the earth'... "In the last days"!
